## Medical Assistance Program (MAP)

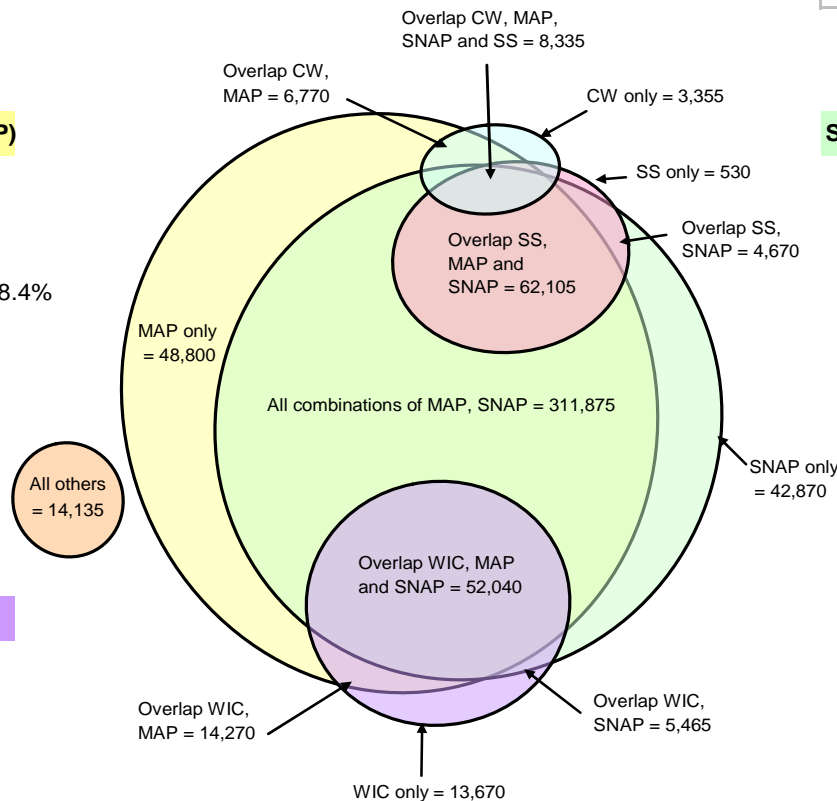
396,795 youth (81.6% of all youth) were eligible for MAP in 2010  
 \*MAP only = 10.0% of all youth  
 \*MAP and SNAP = 12.8%  
 \*Three services including MAP = 28.4%

## All Others

14,135 youth (2.9% of all youth) received services/benefits that did not include MAP, SNAP, SS, CW, or WIC (see program list top right)

## Women, Infants, Children (WIC)

130,515 youth (26.9% of all youth)  
 \*WIC only = 2.8%  
 \*WIC and MAP = 2.9%  
 \*WIC, MAP and SNAP = 10.7%



## Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNA)

368,955 youth (75.9% of all youth) received SNAP benefits at some time during 2010  
 \*SNAP only = 8.8%  
 \*SNAP and MAP only = 12.8%  
 \*Three services including SNAP = 27.1%

## Self Sufficiency (SS)

121,200 youth (24.9% of all youth)  
 \*SS only = 0.1%  
 \*SS and SNAP = 1.0%  
 \*SS, SNAP and MAP = 12.8%

## Child Welfare (CW)

32,390 youth (6.7% of all youth)  
 \*CW only = 0.7%  
 \*CW and MAP = 1.4%  
 \*CW, MAP, SNAP and SS = 1.7%

\*Youth = individuals 0-18 years
