A benefit hosted by the nonprofit Oregon State Hospital Foundation will be held Thursday, November 10, from 7 – 9 p.m. at The Elsinore Theatre, 170 High St. S.E., Salem.

The event coincides with the 30th anniversary of the release of “One Flew Over the Cuckoo’s Nest,” filmed at the Oregon State Hospital, (OSH), and will feature a showing of the documentary describing the making of the film.

"We're very pleased to host this unique event," says OSH Foundation President Dorothy Haun. "Our Foundation members are committed to building for the future and helping provide the best possible services for people with mental illness in Oregon. We also feel very strongly about the need to provide a dedicated and respectful resting place for the cremated remains of former OSH patients."

All proceeds from the benefit will go toward the purchase of treatment-related services for patients and a memorial for patients who have passed away.

Governor Kulongoski, Sen. Peter Courtney, DHS Director Bruce Goldberg, M.D., former OSH Superintendent and cast member Dean Brooks, M.D., OSH Superintendent Marvin Fickle, M.D. and others are scheduled to participate in the event.

“This is an exciting opportunity to support efforts to improve services for patients at the hospital,” says Fickle, “and learn about efforts under way in developing a new state-of-the-art treatment and recovery facility for individuals receiving care.”

The cost to attend the benefit is \$25 per person. Refreshments will be served and attendees will have the opportunity to view and purchase artwork and crafts created by state hospital patients.
