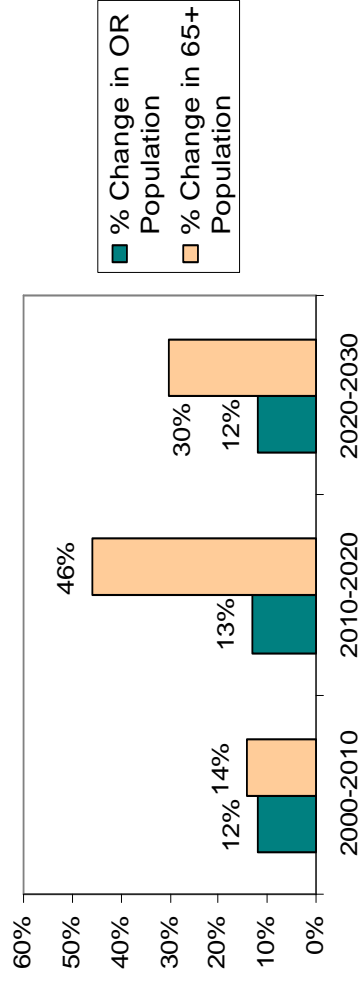

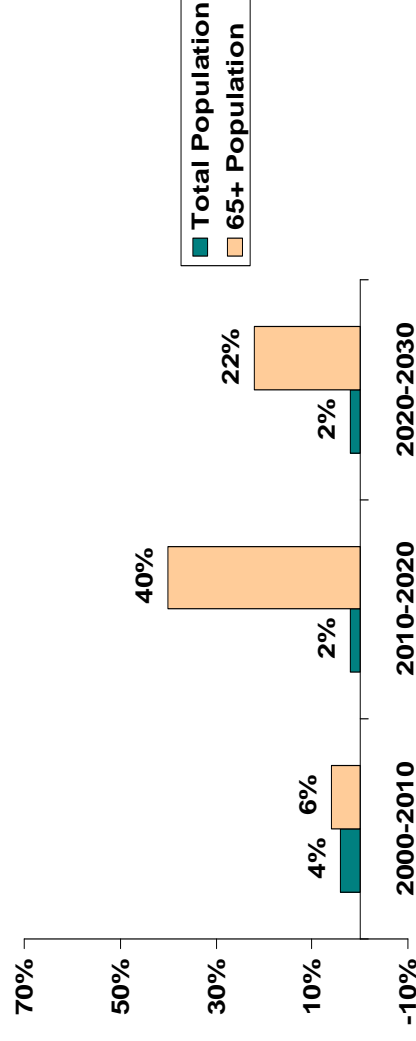

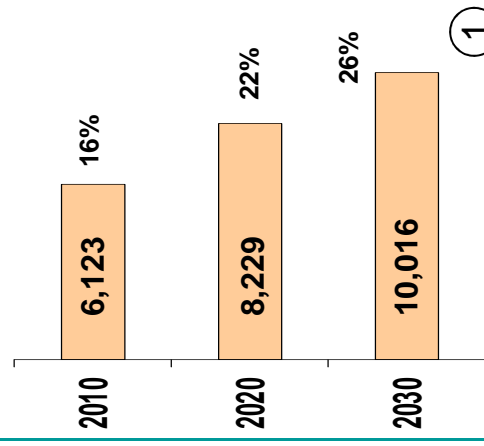
### Growth Rate of Oregon's Aging Population



### Growth Rate of Clatsop County's Aging Population

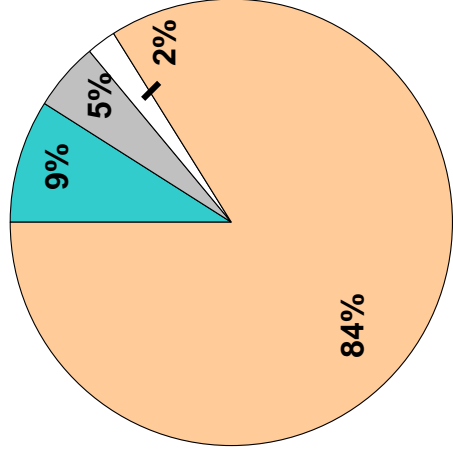


### Clatsop County Projected 65+ Population and % of general population

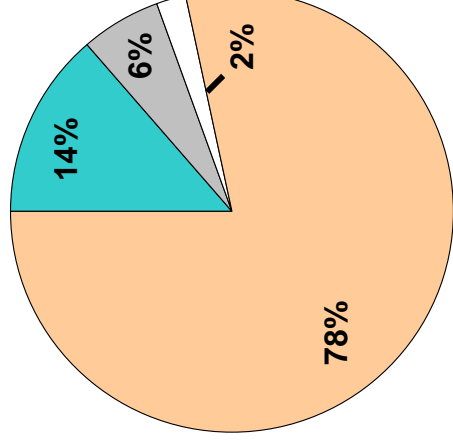

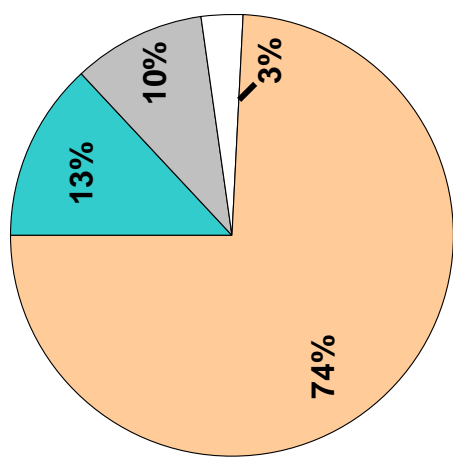

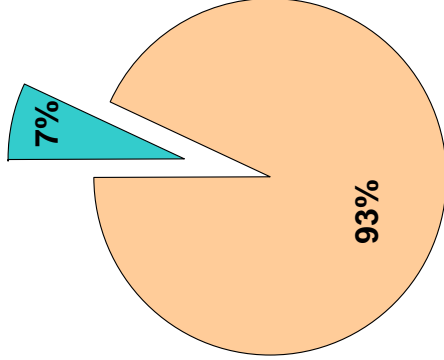

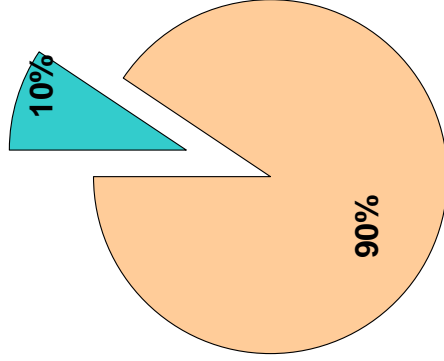

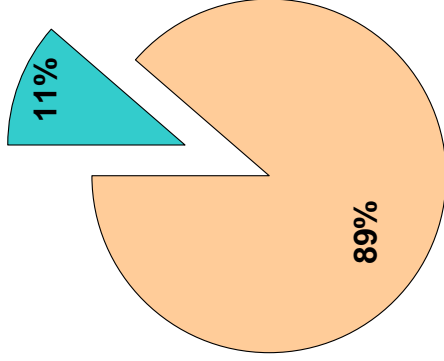

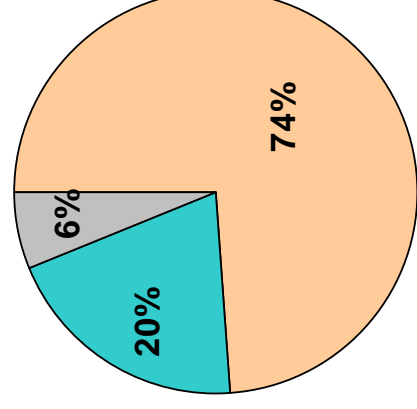

### National % of Seniors Needing Assistance Due to Disability



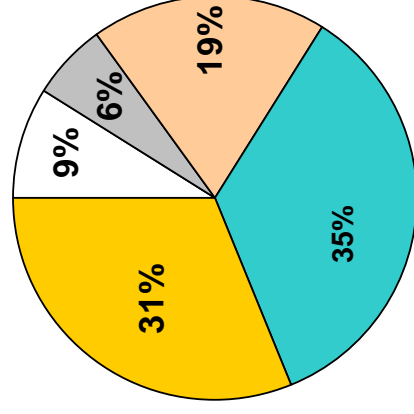
No Disabilities

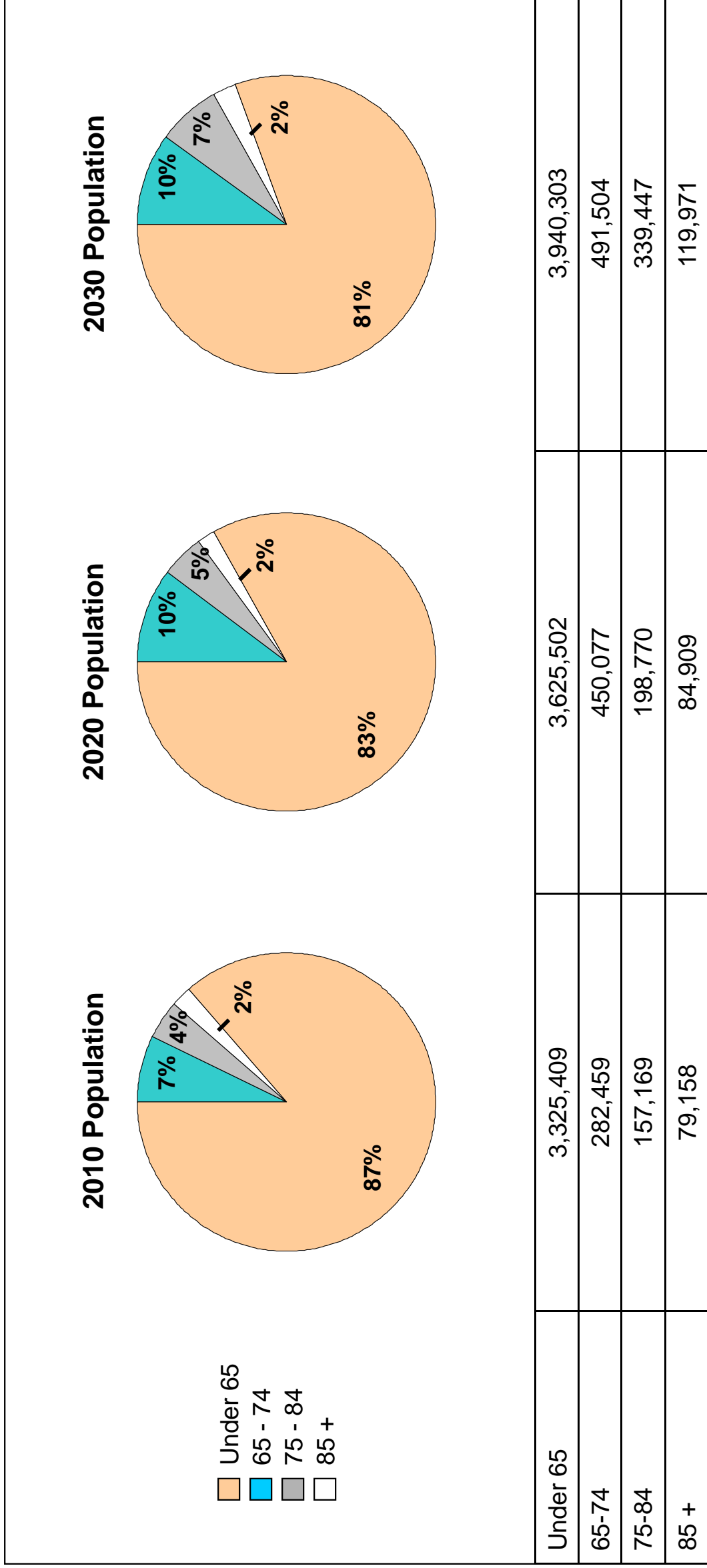
### National % of Seniors and Federal Poverty Level (Monthly Income)
