

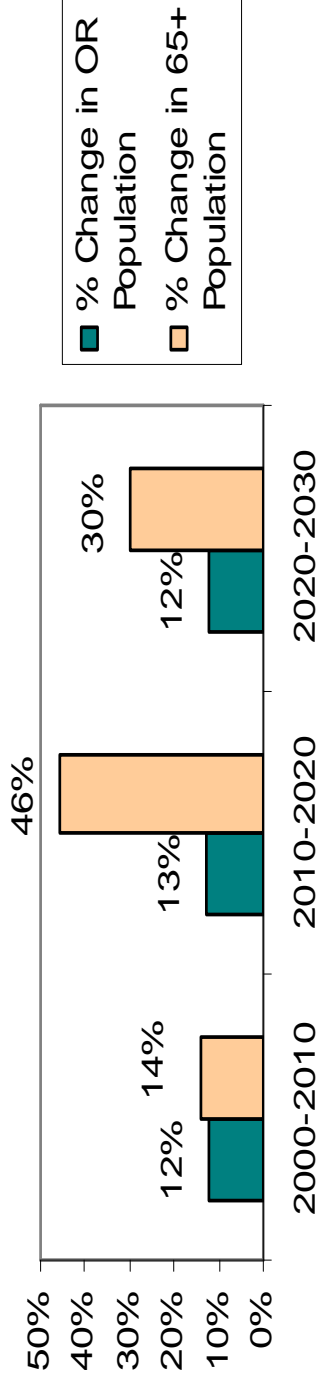

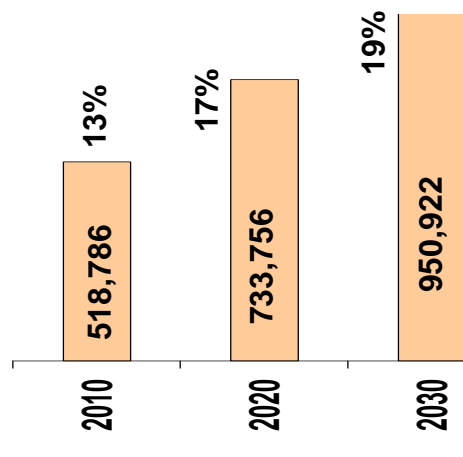

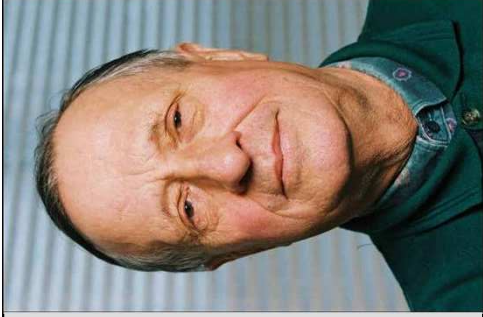
Growth Rate of Oregon's Aging Population

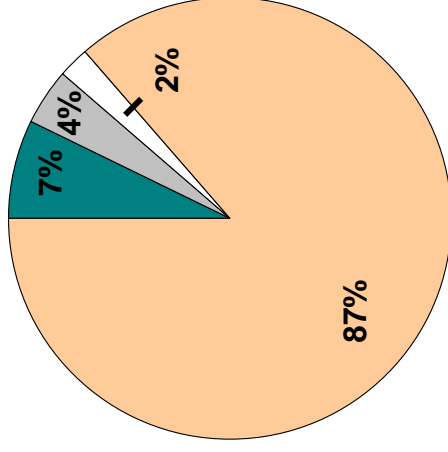

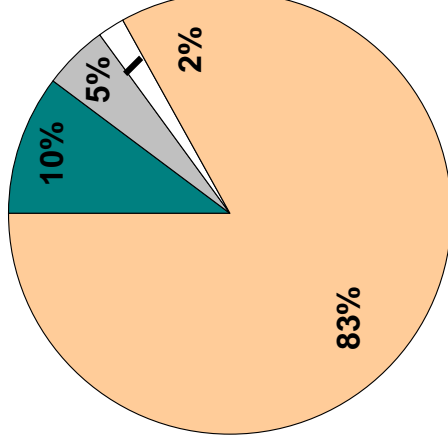

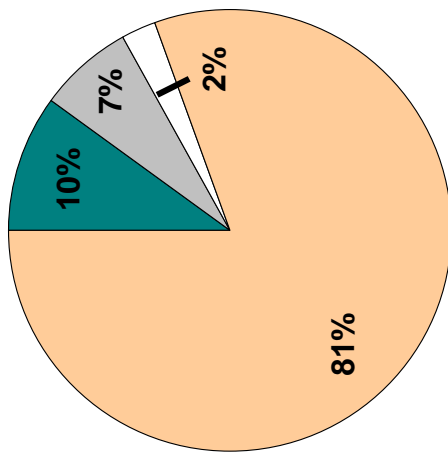
2010 Population

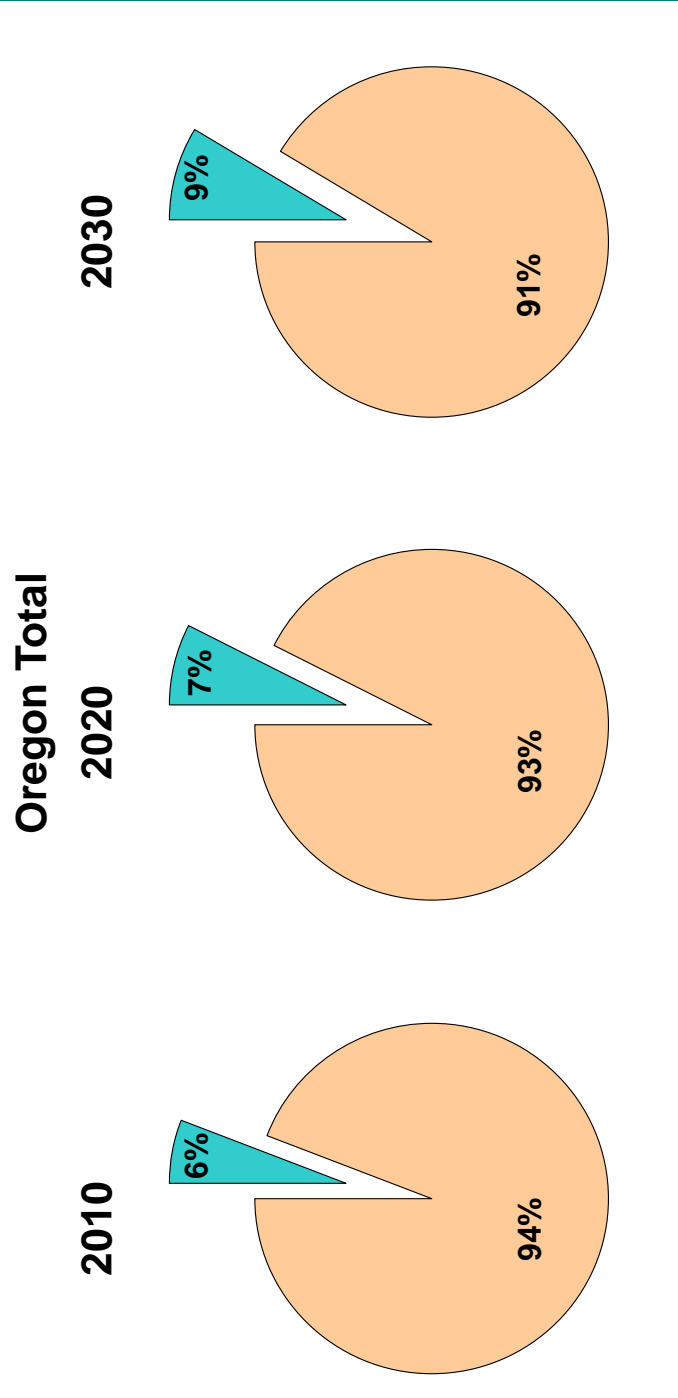

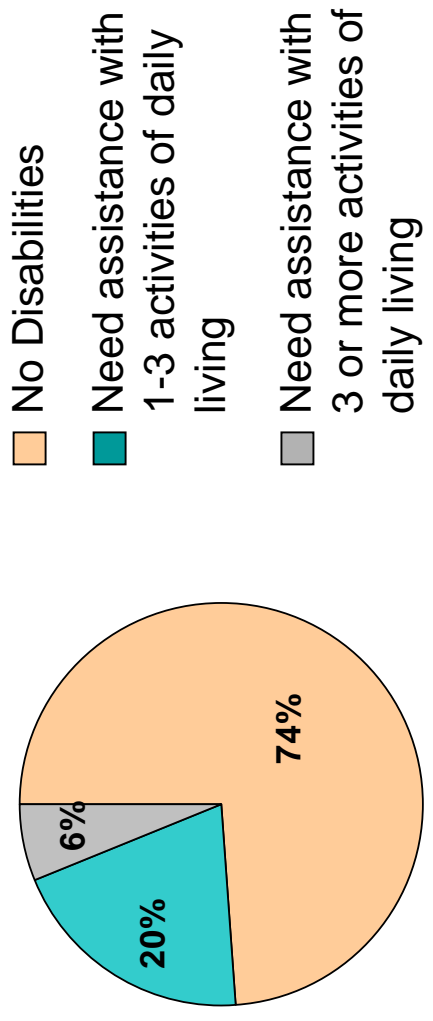

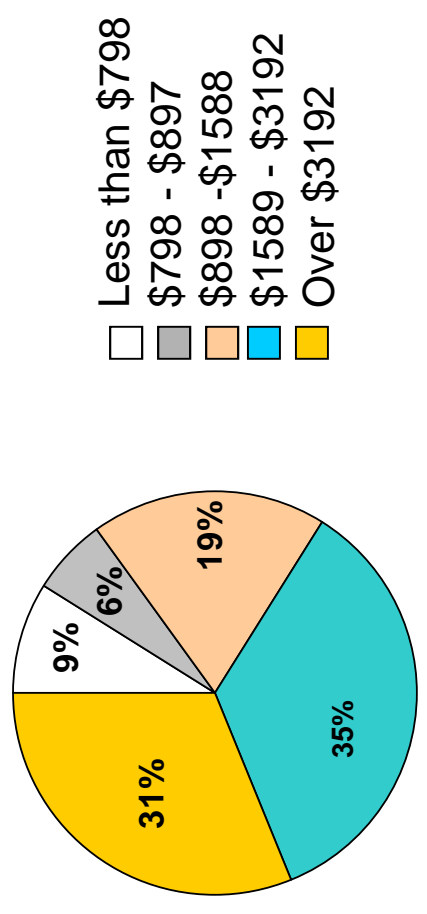


National % of Seniors Needing Assistance Due to Disability
