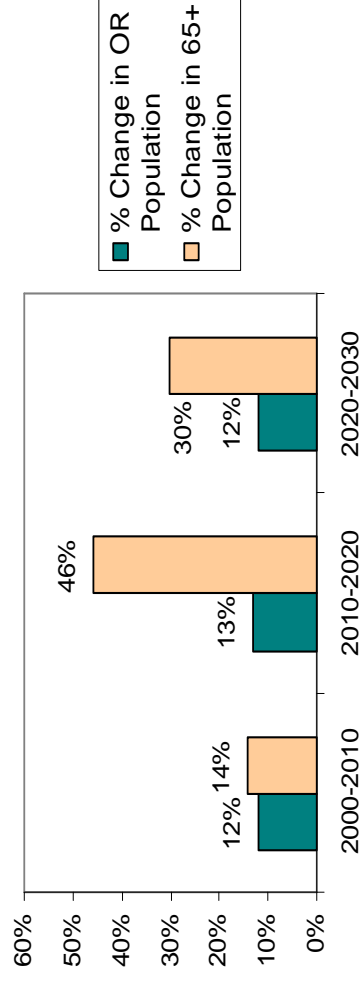

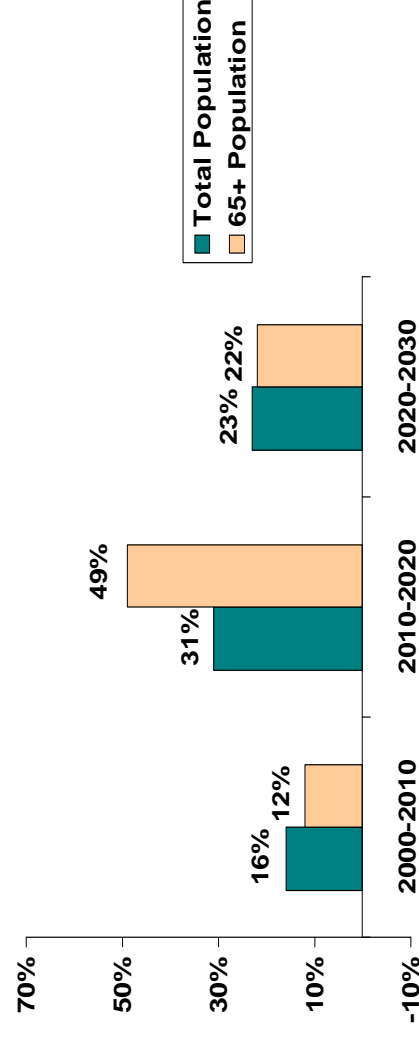

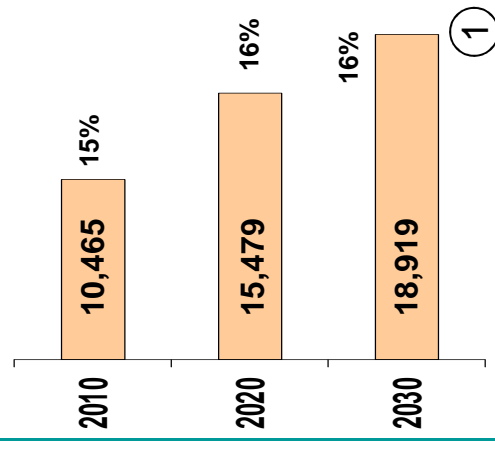
## Growth Rate of Oregon's Aging Population



## Growth Rate Of Polk County's Aging Population

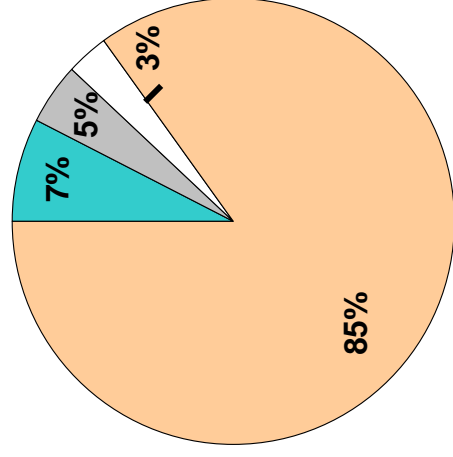


## Polk County Projected 65+ Population and % of general population

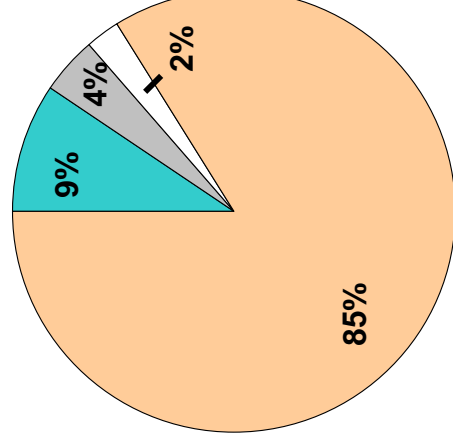

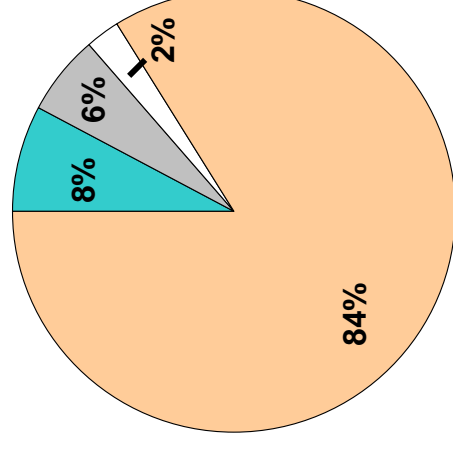

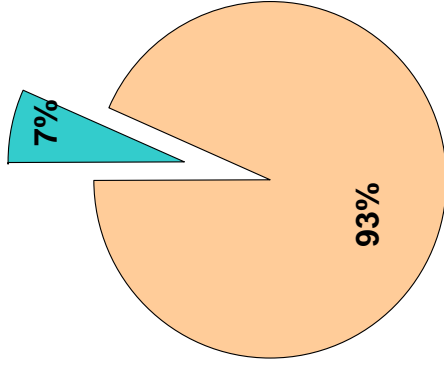

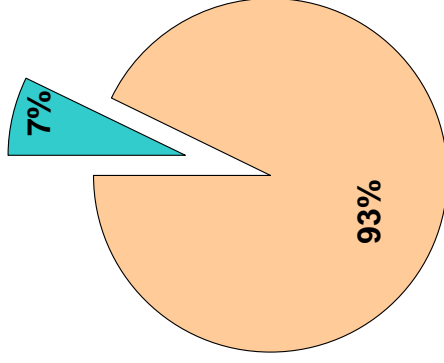

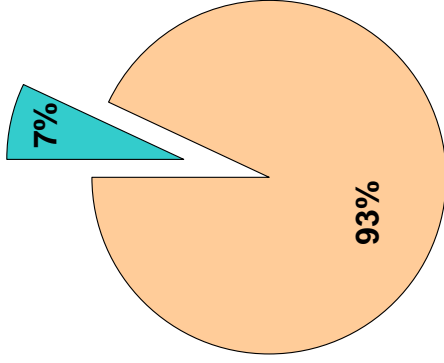

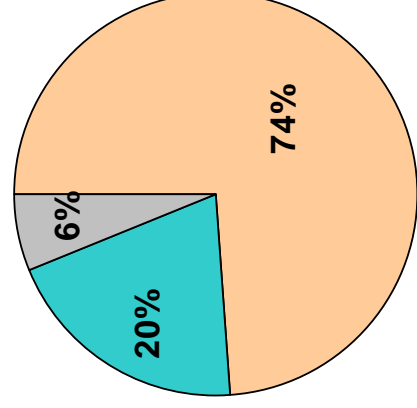

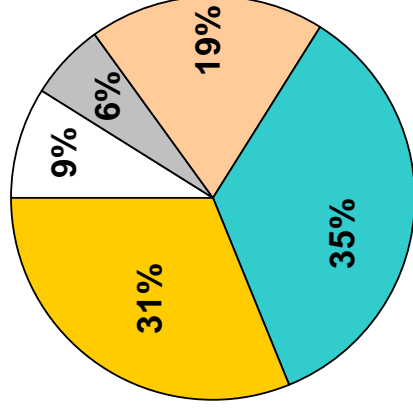
#### National % of Seniors Needing Assistance Due to Disability

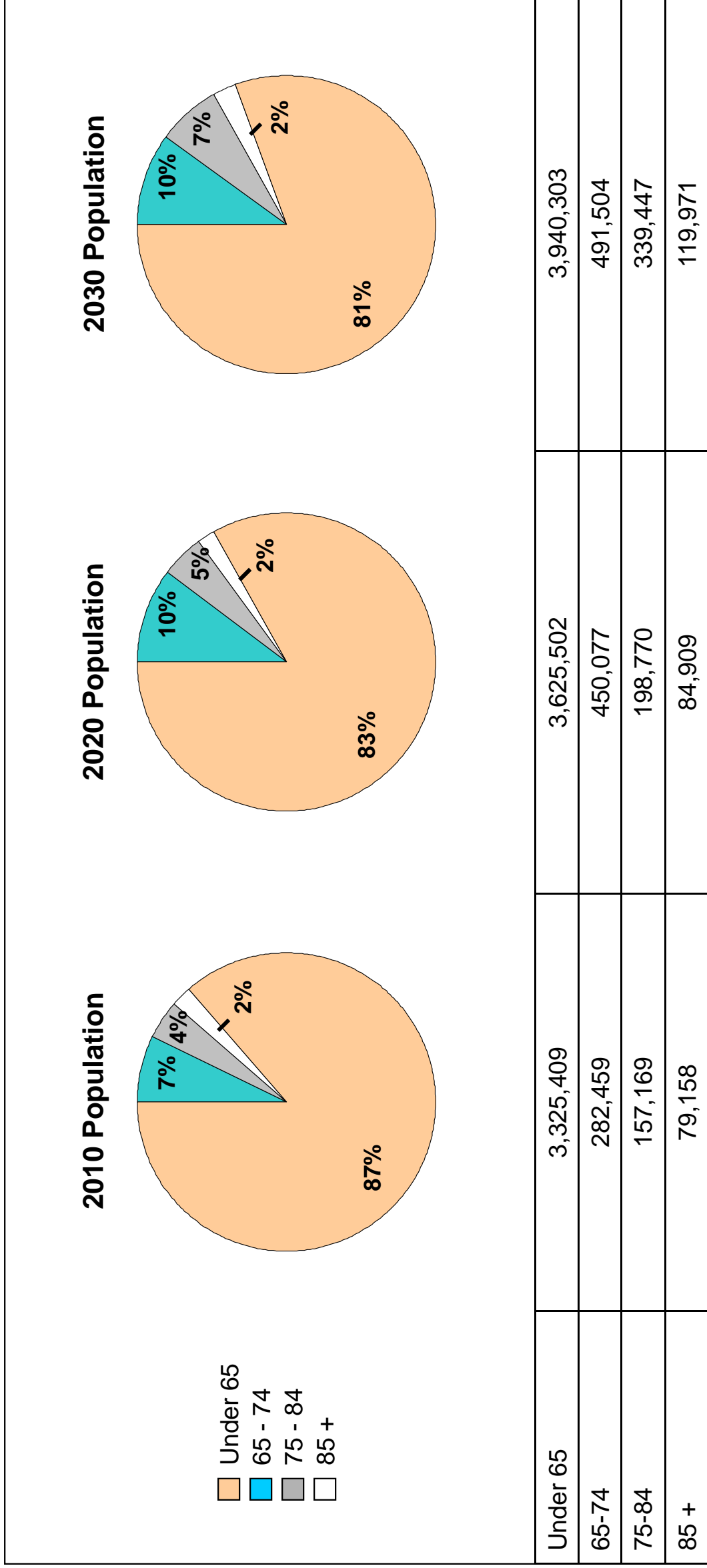
#### National % of Seniors and Federal Poverty Level (Monthly Income)
