

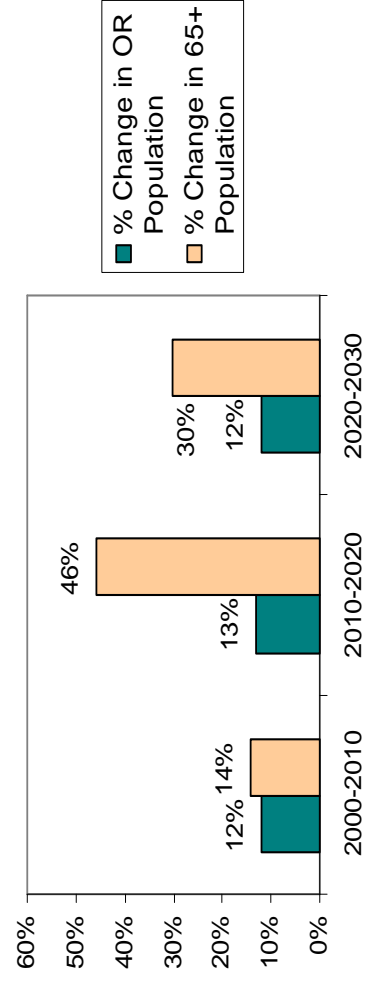

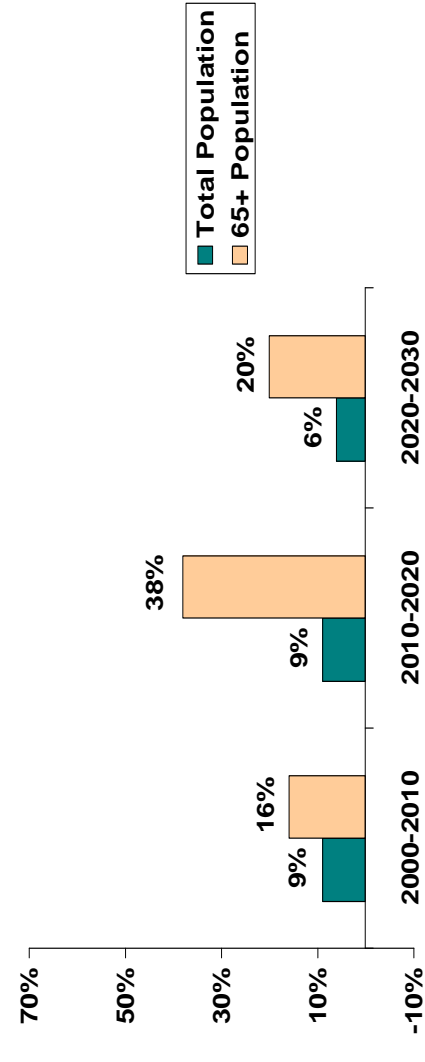

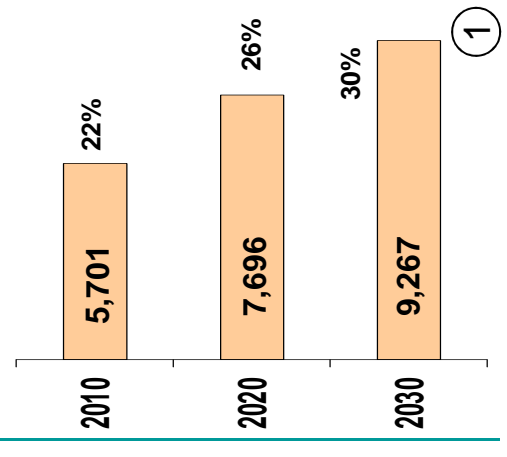
### Growth Rate of Oregon's Aging Population



### Growth Rate Of Tillamook County's Aging Population

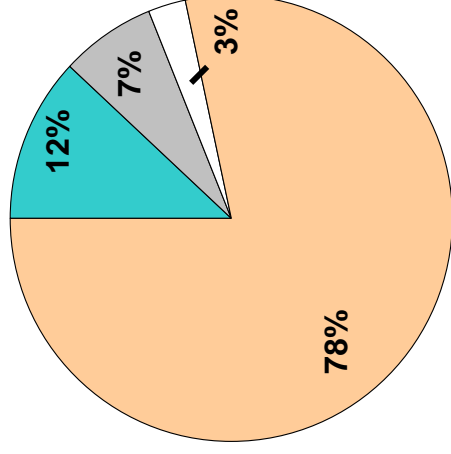


### Tillamook County Projected 65+ Population and % of general population

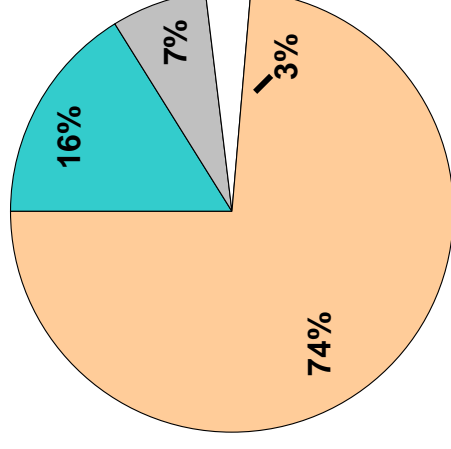

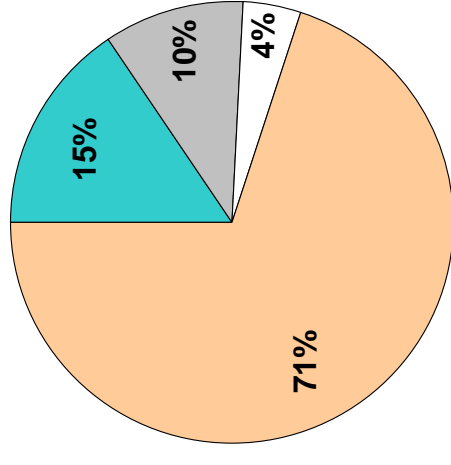

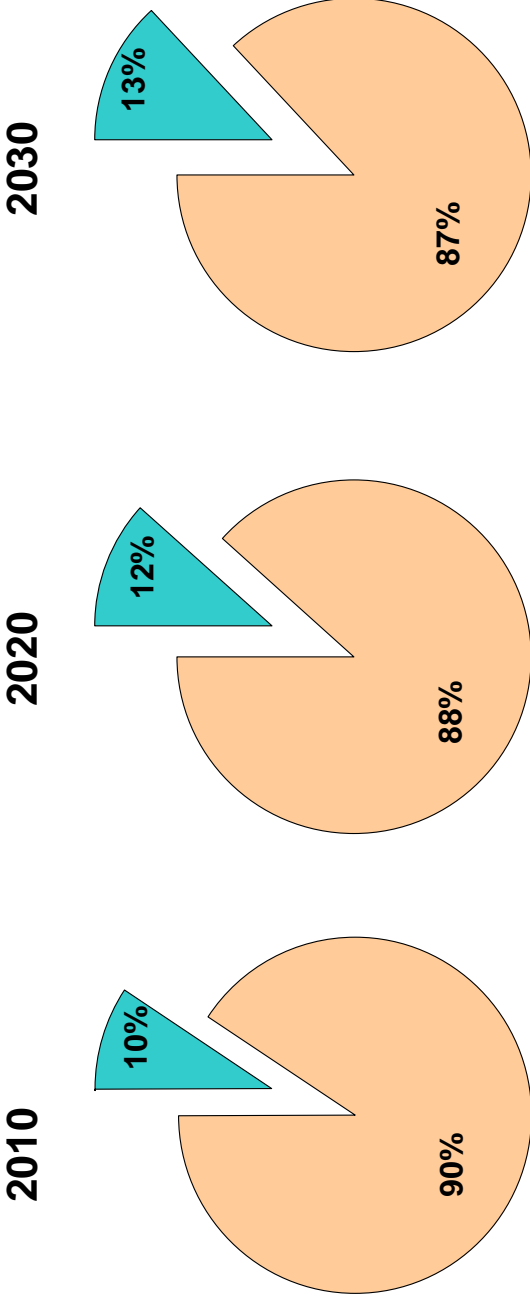

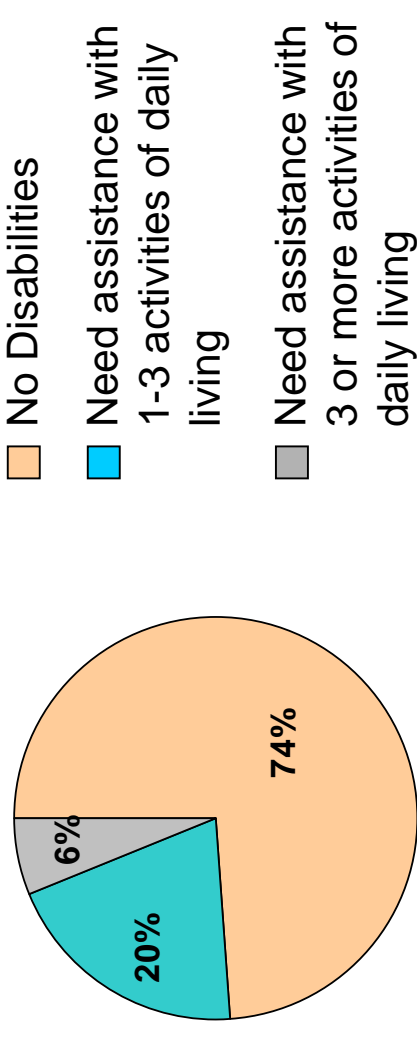

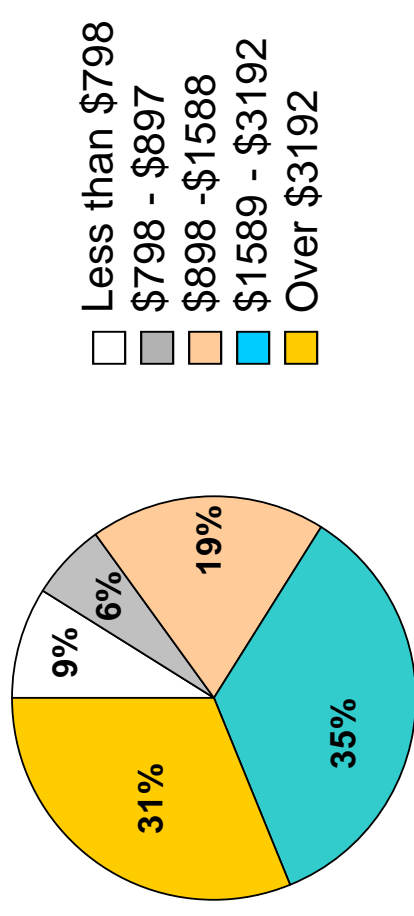

#### National % of Seniors Needing Assistance Due to Disability



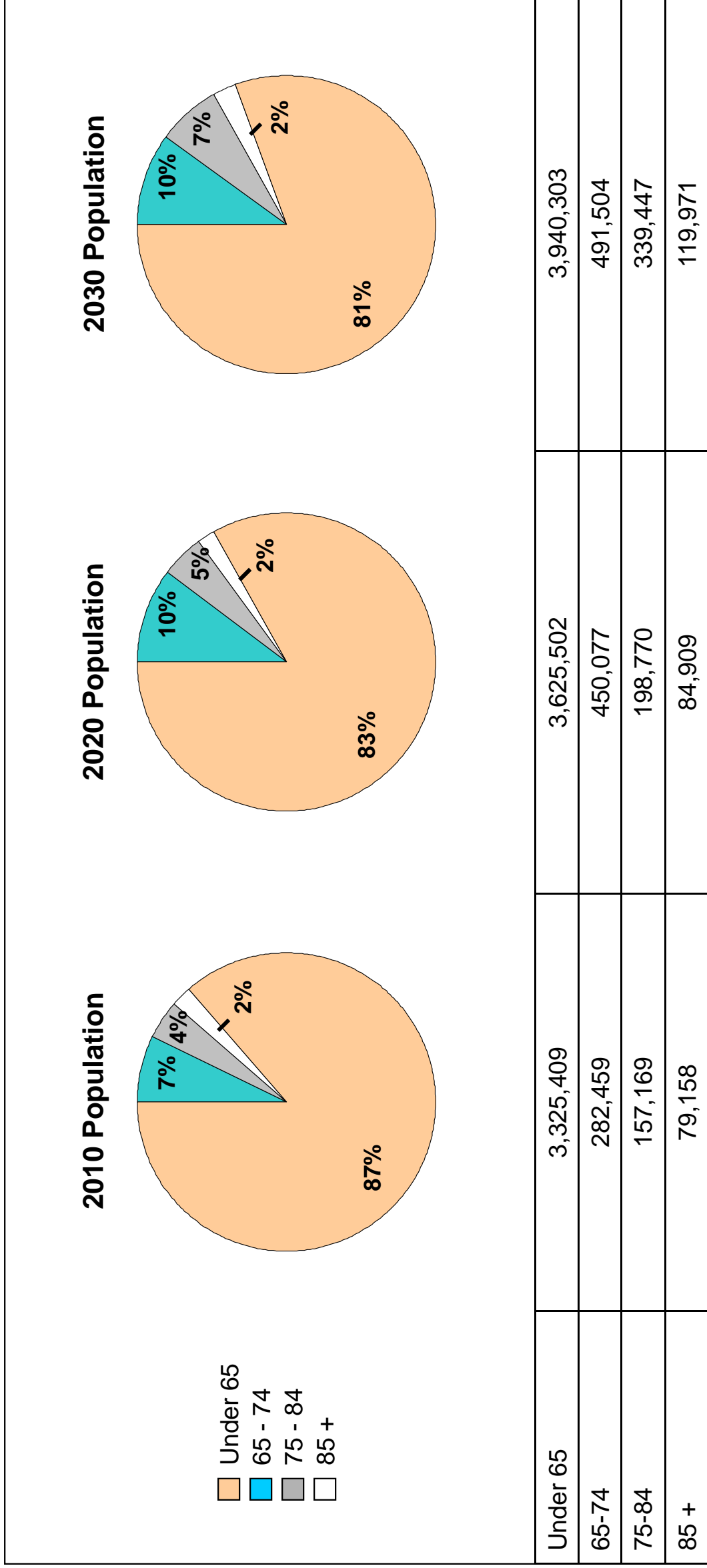
