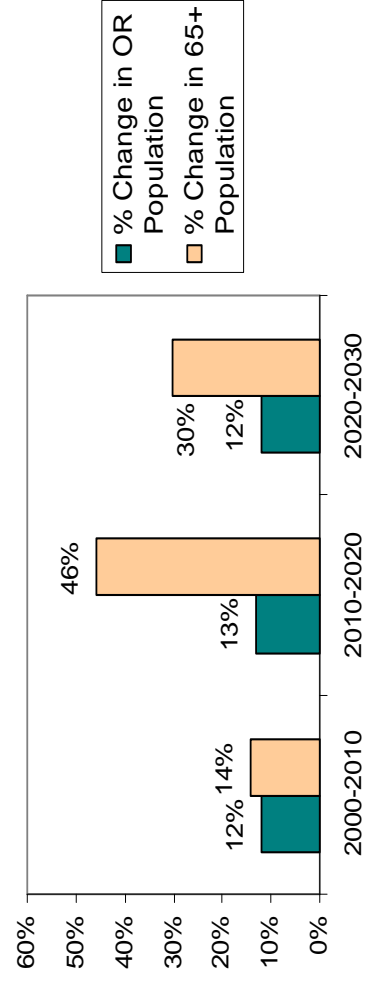

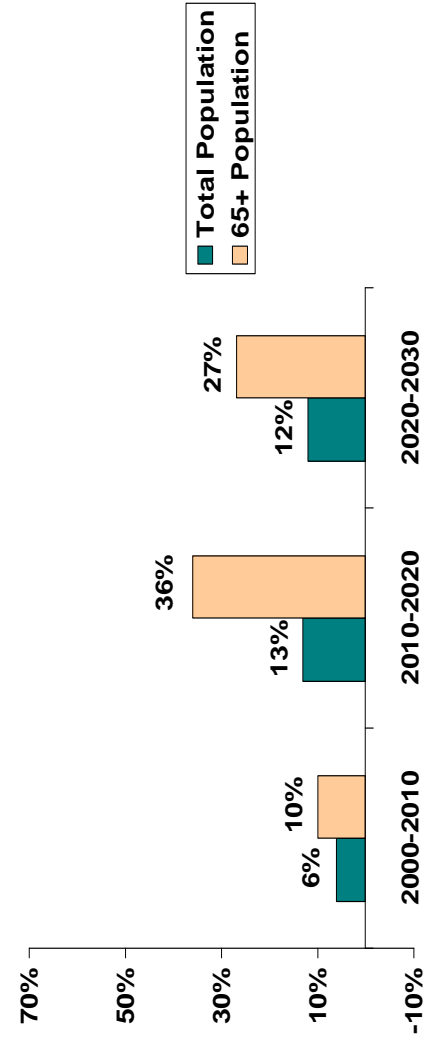

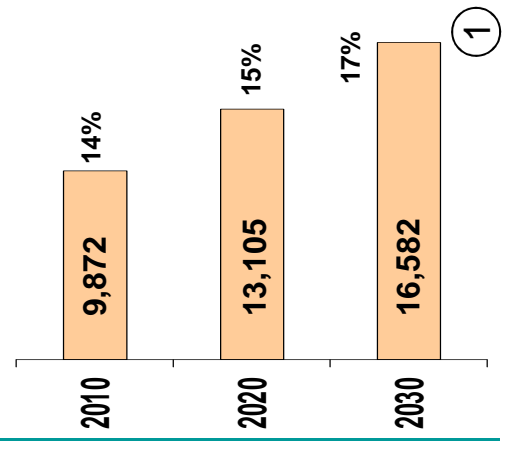
### Growth Rate of Oregon's Aging Population



### Growth Rate of Umatilla County's Aging Population

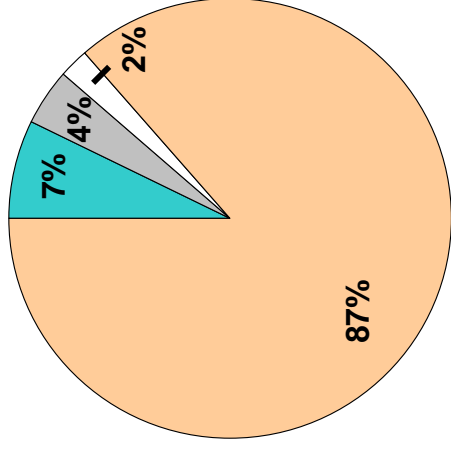


### Umatilla County Projected 65+ Population and % of general population

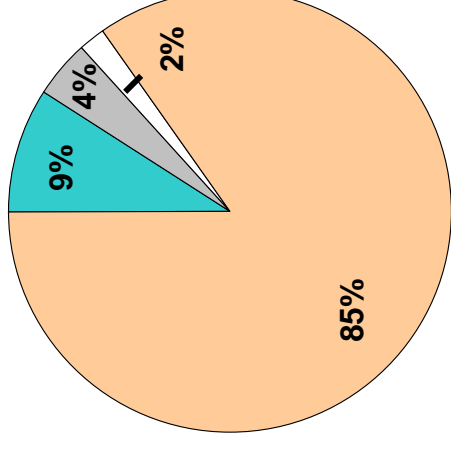

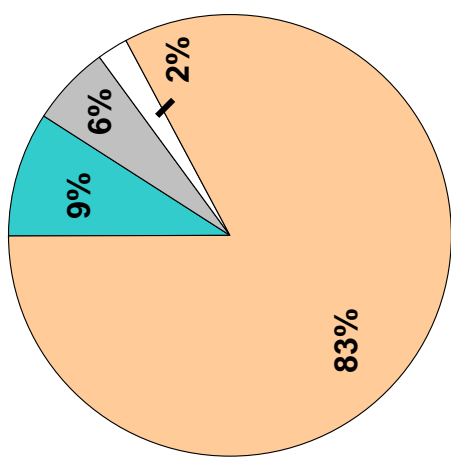

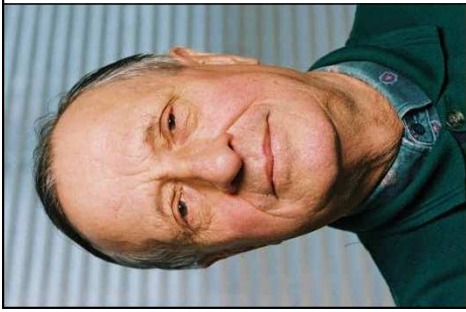

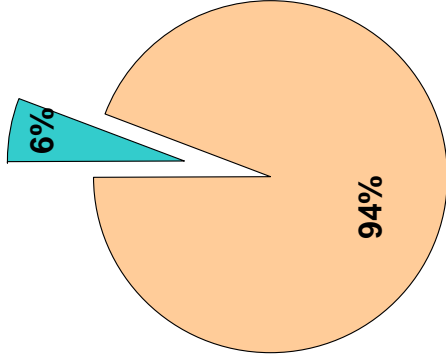

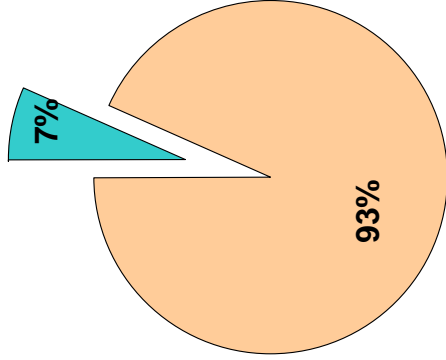

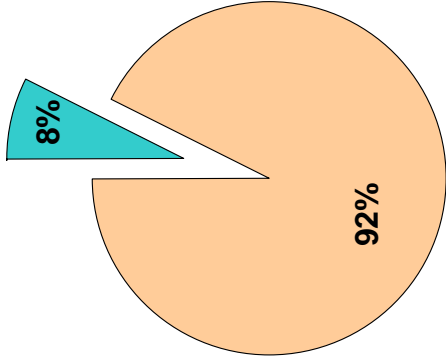

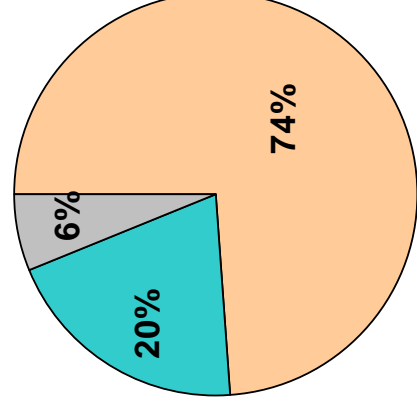

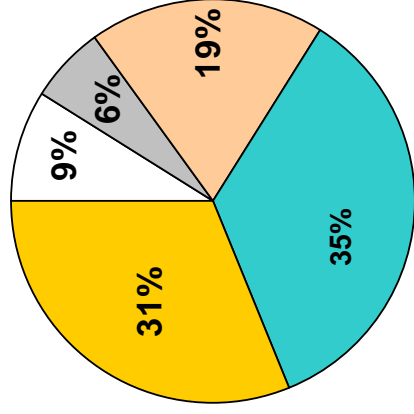
#### National % of Seniors Needing Assistance Due to Disability

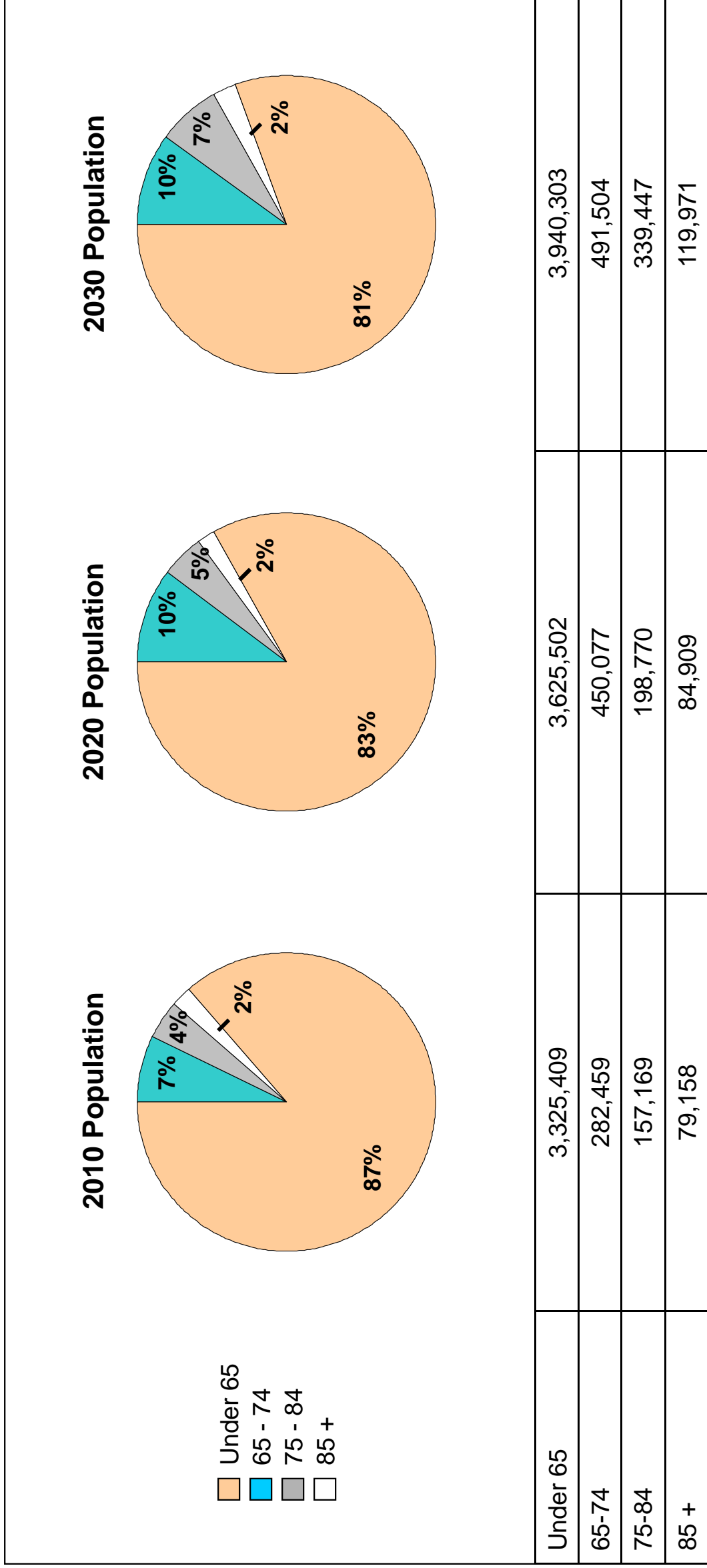
#### National % of Seniors and Federal Poverty Level (Monthly Income)
