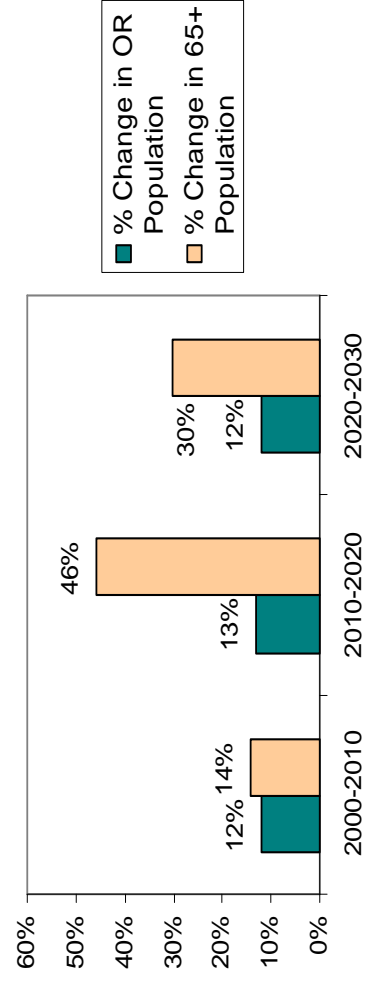

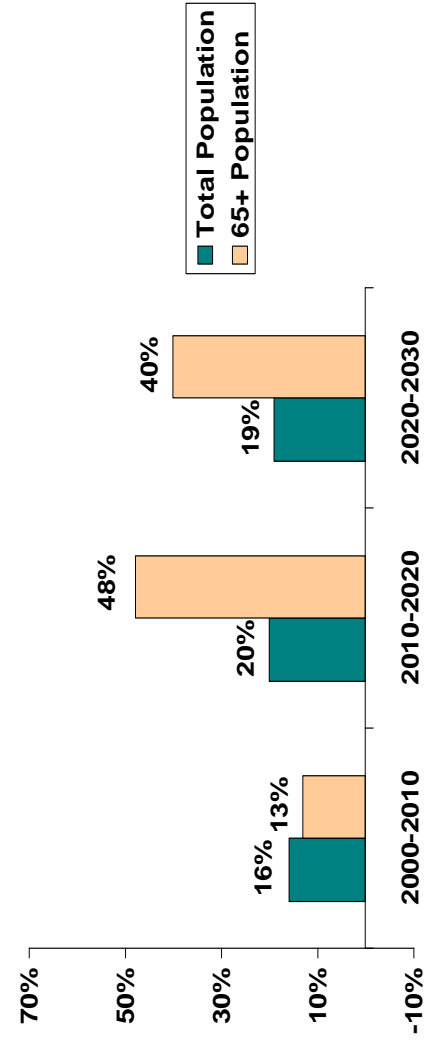

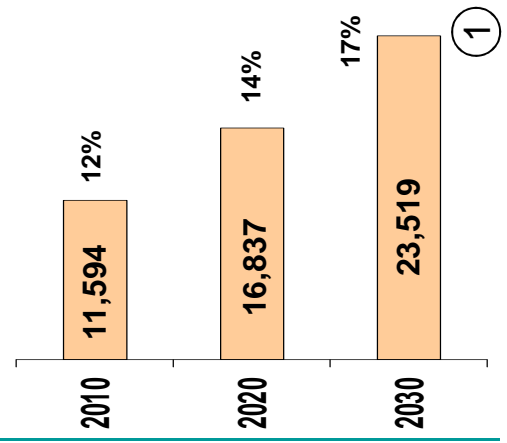
Growth Rate of Oregon's Aging Population



Growth Rate Of Yamhill County's Aging Population

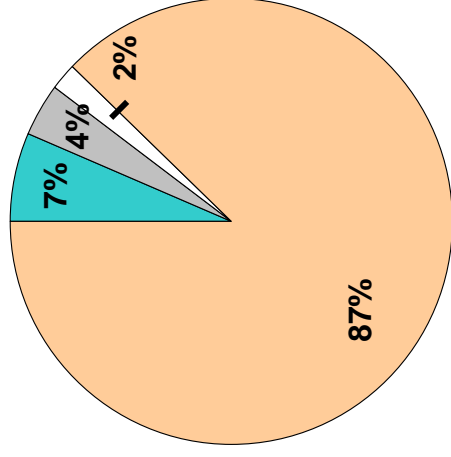


Yamhill County Projected 65+ Population and % of general population

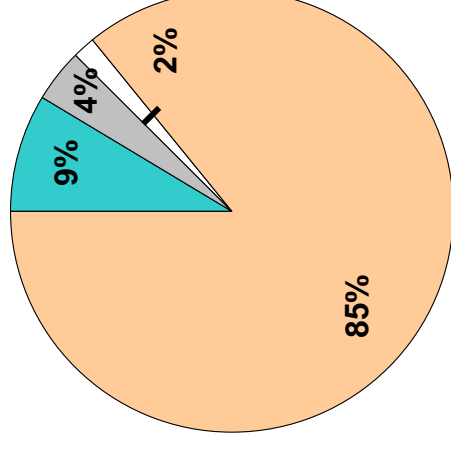

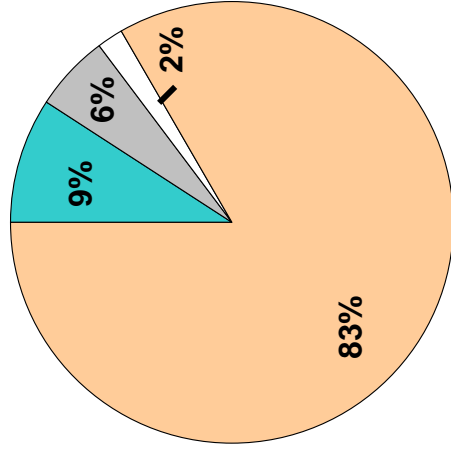

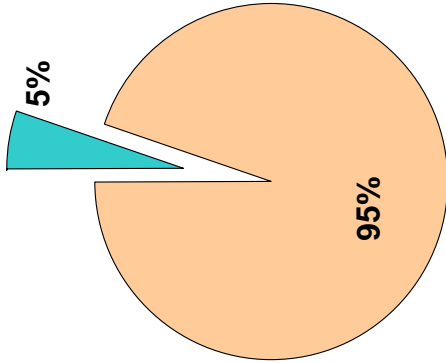

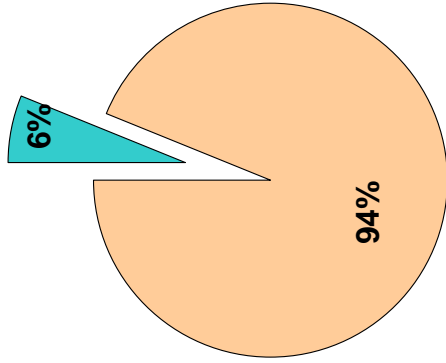

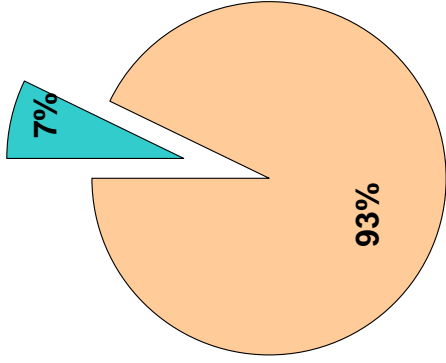

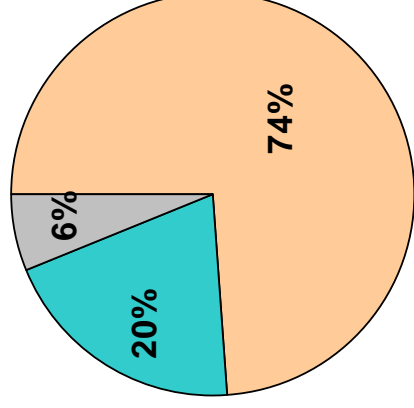

National % of Seniors Needing Assistance Due to Disability



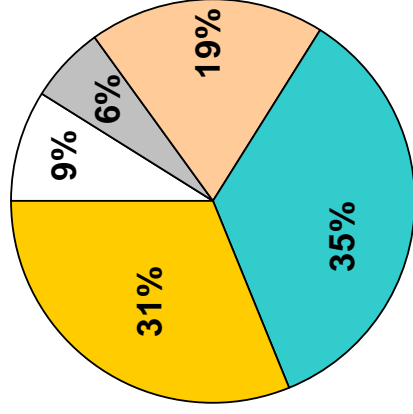
No Disabilities

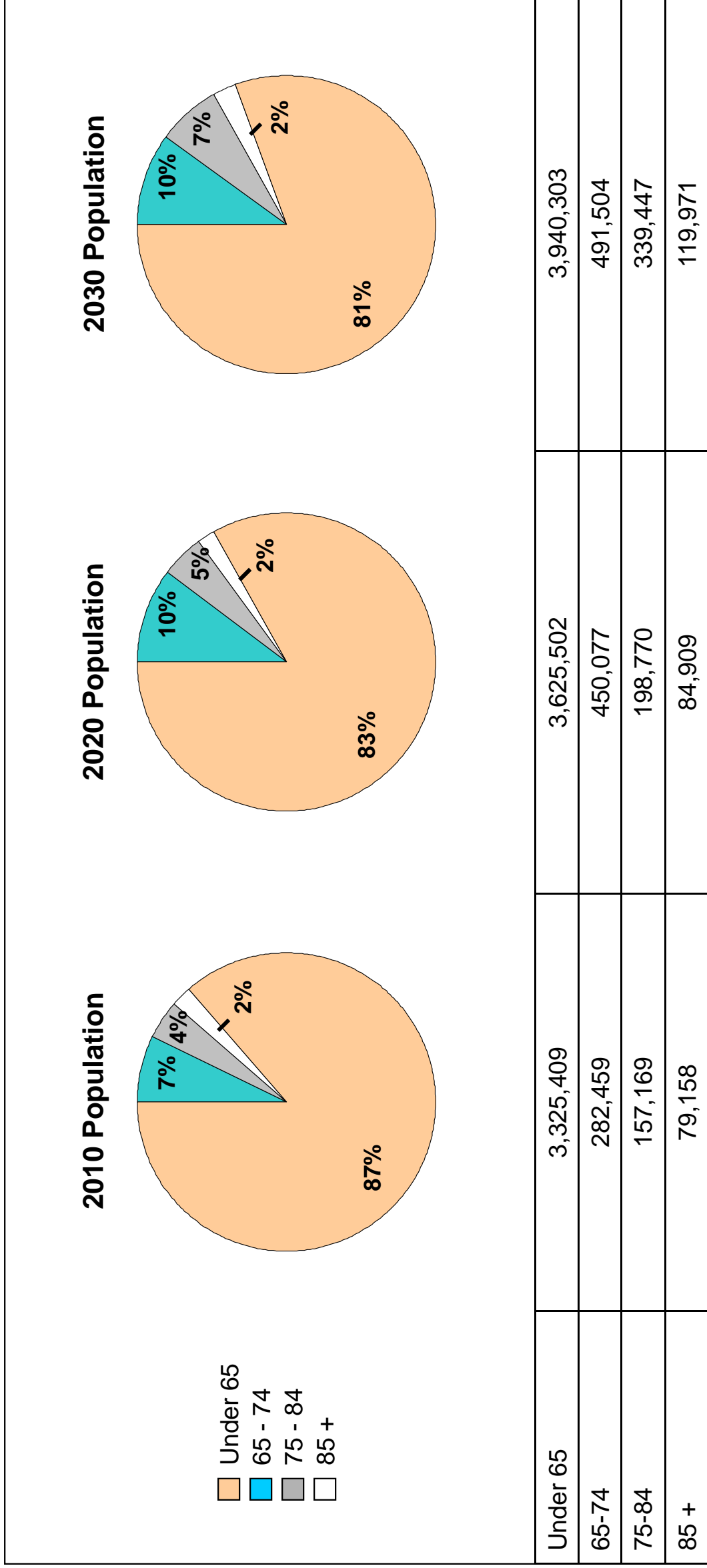
National % of Seniors and Federal Poverty Level (Monthly Income)
